We've come up with the perfect Saturday afternoon date. Instead of bringing her a bouquet, take her to see the *Cut Flowers* exhibition at the Old Train Depot in Battersea, London. The Creative Director of *Vogue*, **Robin Derrick**, is the man behind these vibrant, large-scale photographs of flower arrangements. Akin to a 21st-century Cézanne still life, each work is a digitally manipulated collage of high-resolution images. The 100 hours of post-production on each work gives them a striking, unreal quality. After she's been suitably impressed, take a short cab to the award-winning **Trinity** restaurant in Clapham Old Town. Tuck into the five-course tasting menu – all the better for sharing (*from* £35).
